Easy Cheese Danish From Vera Swain

Preheat oven to 350°

Mix together the following ingredients:

2- 8 oz pkts of softened cream cheese

2 eggs

¾ cup sugar

1 tsp vanilla

Spray bottom of 9 x 12 pan. Place 1 can of crescent rolls in the bottom of the pan (unrolled). Pour cream cheese mixture on top. Unroll another can of crescent rolls and place on top. Bake for approximately 30 minutes (possibly a little longer).

Possible toppings: Powdered Sugar, Use Nuts, Chocolate, Pie Filling, Fruit, Jam/Preserves, etc.

Or just eat it plain!

“Cranberry Candle Holders”

You will need some goblets, cranberries, taper candles and water! . Put a candle into each goblet. Put Cranberries all around the candle to hold it upright. Add water to just below top of cranberries. Do them all different sizes and shape of goblets. This makes a beautiful festive centerpiece. Great for Thanksgiving and Christmas!

Bonnie enjoys preserving the beauty and symbolism of each leaf in a permanent art form. The process she uses is called concrete casting.

Their passion for art is evident in the craftsmanship and quality of the pieces they create.
